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LỜI NÓI ĐẦU

Tiếng Anh 5 – Global Success – Sách học sinh, tập hai được Nhà xuất bản Giáo dục Việt Nam tổ chức biên soạn theo “Chương trình Giáo dục phổ thông: Chương trình môn Tiếng Anh” (từ lớp 3 đến lớp 12) ban hành theo Thông tư 32/2018/TT-BGDĐT ngày 26 tháng 12 năm 2018 của Bộ Giáo dục và Đào tạo, với sự hợp tác chặt chẽ về chuyên môn và kỹ thuật của Nhà xuất bản Macmillan (MPC). Sách được biên soạn theo đường hướng giao tiếp, giúp học sinh bước đầu hình thành và phát triển năng lực giao tiếp bằng tiếng Anh, thông qua bốn kỹ năng nghe, nói, đọc và viết, trong đó ưu tiên phát triển hai kỹ năng nghe và nói.

Tiếng Anh 5 – Global Success – Sách học sinh, tập hai xoay quanh hai chủ điểm giao tiếp gắn gũi với học sinh: *Me and My Family* và *Me and the World Around*. Mỗi chủ điểm được chia thành năm đơn vị bài học (Unit) tương ứng với năm chủ đề của chương trình. Sau năm đơn vị bài học là một bài ôn (Review) giúp học sinh ôn tập và củng cố các kỹ năng giao tiếp (nghe, nói, đọc, viết) và kiến thức ngôn ngữ cơ bản (ngữ âm, từ vựng, ngữ pháp). Trong phần Review có bổ sung thêm các hoạt động mở rộng (Extension activities) với các nội dung tích hợp liên môn, giúp học sinh mở rộng kiến thức về các lĩnh vực khoa học, văn hoá ... thông qua các hoạt động học bằng tiếng Anh.

Tiếng Anh 5 – Global Success – Sách học sinh, tập hai được biên soạn dựa trên những cơ sở lý luận và thực tiễn của việc dạy và học tiếng Anh tiểu học ở Việt Nam, có tính đến tâm lý lứa tuổi và giao lưu quốc tế.

Các tác giả rất mong nhận được những ý kiến đóng góp của các nhà giáo, phụ huynh học sinh và đông đảo bạn đọc quan tâm để sách được hoàn thiện hơn.
